




Project Love Bug

Meeting Location/Project Shop Location

With the exception of the Winter Months (Jan thru March), we hold general meetings on the 2nd Monday of each month on the main level of the annex to Our Redeemer Lutheran Church at 910 Wood Ave in Rapid City from 7 pm to 9 pm. In the winter months, we meet on the 2nd Saturday of the month after the Toymaking Workshop, starting at 11 am.

Until Sept 1, 2024, Project Workshops are held at the "WOOD" SHOP at 910 WOOD Ave on the second and fourth Saturday mornings from 9 am to noon. In September, we begin meeting every Saturday morning in preparation for Toy Distribution Day on Dec 7, 2024. The WOOD SHOP on WOOD Ave is located in the basement of the annex to Our Redeemer Lutheran Church at 910 Wood Ave in Rapid City. You can enter the WOOD SHOP thru the brown door on the east side of the building. Parking is available on the east and south sides of the building. Wood and supplies are stored at an off-site location.

Purpose of the RCWA

The RCWA exists for two main reasons: (1) To exchange information that will enhance the enjoyment and skills of woodworking; and (2) To promote woodworking as a hobby, as a profession, or anywhere in between. The focus of the RCWA is woodworking in general. We discuss everything from the phenomenon of seasonal wood movement, to finishing techniques, to table-saw tuning, to shop safety. Members include a mixture of hand-tool (Galoot) and power tool (Normite) enthusiasts.

Except for Jan-Mar, the RCWA meets on the 2nd Monday of the month at 7:00 p.m. on the main floor of the annex to OUR REDEEMER LUTHERAN CHURCH at 910 WOOD Avenue in Rapid City. Each general meeting has a theme with one main topic, which is presented and discussed. It's a great opportunity to meet fellow woodworkers, share ideas, seek advice, and get out of the sawdust for a while. We cordially invite men and women of all ages who have any interest in woodworking, both hobby and professional, to attend our meetings.







Club for Boys Assistance July 8-10, 2024

Members of the RCWA came to the Shop at the Club for Boys (CFB) this week (July 8-9-10, 2024) to provide assistance with the Pinewood Derby race car preparation effort for about 100 members of the Club for Boys.

The race cars were traced and cut from 2x4's by members of the Rapid City Woodworkers in the spring of 2024. Wheels (400 @ 2") were donated to the project this year by the RCWA. Dowels for axles (1/4") were provided by the CFB. The RCWA provided the leadership and production assistance to guide a group of more than 100 boys thru the steps needed to build and finalize cars for the races planned for the following week. Sturgis Threshing Bee - August 17, 2024

The RCWA toymakers set up in the Memorial Building at the Sturgis Threshing Bee on August 17, 2024, at 8:30 am. The temperature was in the low 60's at the start of the day with gusty winds from the north. It warmed up to 85 degrees by 4 pm.

We brought tractors and vans for kids to color and then build into racing vehicles by adding wheels. We brought tractors cut from redwood, pine, and cedar, pre-drilled for wheels. Additionally, we brought a box of vans. Kids were given a choice of tractors or vans. As it turns out, we gave away 57+3=60 tractors and 38 vans, for a total of 98 toys. Every one of them got tested on our 8' race track! We gave out our last toys a little before 4 pm, before we packed up and traveled home.

The RCWA will support this fundraising event by bringing free blank unfinished wooden toy giraffes and vans for kids to color with crayons. When the kids are finished coloring, we will install wheels on each toy. We'll be bringing blanks, wheels, axles, and glue, wheel presses, jigs and crayons. We will bring a race track for the kids to race their toys after coloring.

The location is the Old Storybook Island at 2911 Canyon Lake Dr, Rapid City, SD. We will setup at 9 am, the event starts at 10 am. (Note: This picnic area is across the creek from Story Book Island.)


