

Turtle Banks are in the house...

SS SIG: Oct 17, 2024

The Scrollsaw Special Interest Group (SS SIG) was held today from 1 pm to 3 pm at Rick's shop in Black Hawk. Attending: Ken, Bob, Kathie, and Rick

Today's discussion centered on how to build a small working router table for making 1/8" roundover passes. This is important in finishing off many smaller toy parts. The smaller bit allows you to get into tight spots on the toy.



Show and Tell: Rick explained the techniques he uses to make the plexiglass windows used on the Turtle Banks. It is a combination of CNC router for cutting the plexiglass, and then a jig he uses to hold the plexiglass, so he can safely drill the holes for the brass pins used to hold the plexiglass to the turtle bank bodies.









WT SIG: Oct 30,2024

Ken Ketel and Michael Howard hosted today's Woodturning SIG at the West Hills Shop on Oct 30 @ 1:00 PM. The West Hills kitchen provided tasty rice crispy treats and coffee. Two types of turnings work well as Christmas tree ornaments: A simple cube with finials added, and an inside out turning based on the pattern below. The steps used for "inside out turnings" are illustrated in the first photo.







A simple cube is the starter for the red ornament.






Project Love Bug

With the exception of the Winter Months (Jan thru March), we hold general meetings on the 2nd Monday of each month on the main level of the annex to Our Redeemer Lutheran Church at 910 Wood Ave in Rapid City from 7 pm to 9 pm. In the winter months, we meet on the 2nd Saturday of the month after the Toymaking Workshop, starting at 11 am.

Until Sept 1, 2024, Project Workshops are held at the "WOOD" SHOP at 910 WOOD Ave on the second and fourth Saturday mornings from 9 am to noon. In September, we begin meeting every Saturday morning in preparation for Toy Distribution Day on Dec 7, 2024. The WOOD SHOP on WOOD Ave is located in the basement of the annex to Our Redeemer Lutheran Church at 910 Wood Ave in Rapid City. You can enter the WOOD SHOP thru the brown door on the east side of the building. Parking is available on the east and south sides of the building. Wood and supplies are stored at an off-site location.

Purpose of the RCWA

The RCWA exists for two main reasons: (1) To exchange information that will enhance the enjoyment and skills of woodworking; and (2) To promote woodworking as a hobby, as a profession, or anywhere in between. The focus of the RCWA is woodworking in general. We discuss everything from the phenomenon of seasonal wood movement, to finishing techniques, to table-saw tuning, to shop safety. Members include a mixture of hand-tool (Galoot) and power tool (Normite) enthusiasts.

Except for Jan-Mar, the RCWA meets on the 2nd Monday of the month at 7:00 p.m. on the main floor of the annex to OUR REDEEMER LUTHERAN CHURCH at 910 WOOD Avenue in Rapid City. Each general meeting has a theme with one main topic, which is presented and discussed. It's a great opportunity to meet fellow woodworkers, share ideas, seek advice, and get out of the sawdust for a while. We cordially invite men and women of all ages who have any interest in woodworking, both hobby and professional, to attend our meetings.


