
RCWA Events since the Last Newsletter Release

Phase 2: Cutting toys to shape


Phase 3: Milling - routering, drilling, machine sanding Phase 4: Finish - sealer coat - sanding - spray - sanding


Scroll Saw Special Interest Group (SS SIG): April 17, 2025


Woodturning Special Interest Group (WT SIG) 4-30-2025



Both machining and laser engraving ideas are welcome. This Saturday, the plan was to work on a sign that has a couple of components. We talked about combining or merging several elements, exploring height base operations, and trying different gap settings for overall height, adding some engraved (or raised) letters, and virtually exploring some letters to get the effect we want.

Until Sept 1, 2025, Project Workshops are held at the "WOOD" SHOP at 910 WOOD Ave on the second and fourth Saturday mornings from 9 am to noon. In September, we begin meeting every Saturday morning in preparation for Toy Distribution Day on Dec 6, 2025. The WOOD SHOP on WOOD Ave is located in the basement of the annex to Our Redeemer Lutheran Church at 910 Wood Ave in Rapid City. You can enter the WOOD SHOP thru the brown door on the east side of the building. Parking is available on the east and south sides of the building. Wood and supplies are stored at an off-site location.

Purpose of the RCWA

The RCWA exists for two main reasons: (1) To exchange information that will enhance the enjoyment and skills of woodworking; and (2) To promote woodworking as a hobby, as a profession, or anywhere in between.

The focus of the RCWA is woodworking in general. We discuss everything from the phenomenon of seasonal wood movement, to finishing techniques, to table-saw tuning, to shop safety. Members include a mixture of hand-tool (Galoot) and power tool (Normite) enthusiasts.




